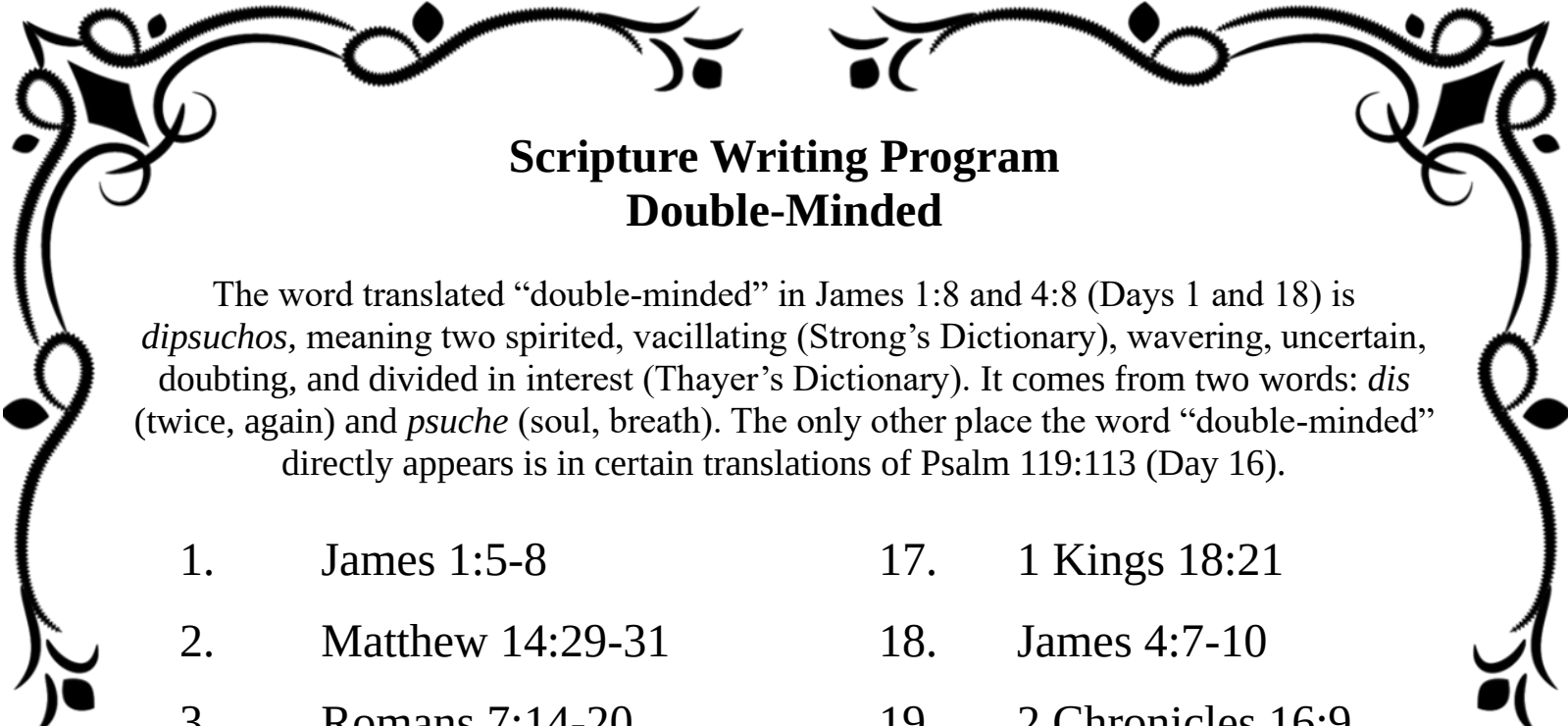




Scripture Writing Program Double-Minded

The word translated “double-minded” in James 1:8 and 4:8 (Days 1 and 18) is *dipsuchos*, meaning two spirited, vacillating (Strong’s Dictionary), wavering, uncertain, doubting, and divided in interest (Thayer’s Dictionary). It comes from two words: *dis* (twice, again) and *psuche* (soul, breath). The only other place the word “double-minded” directly appears is in certain translations of Psalm 119:113 (Day 16).
