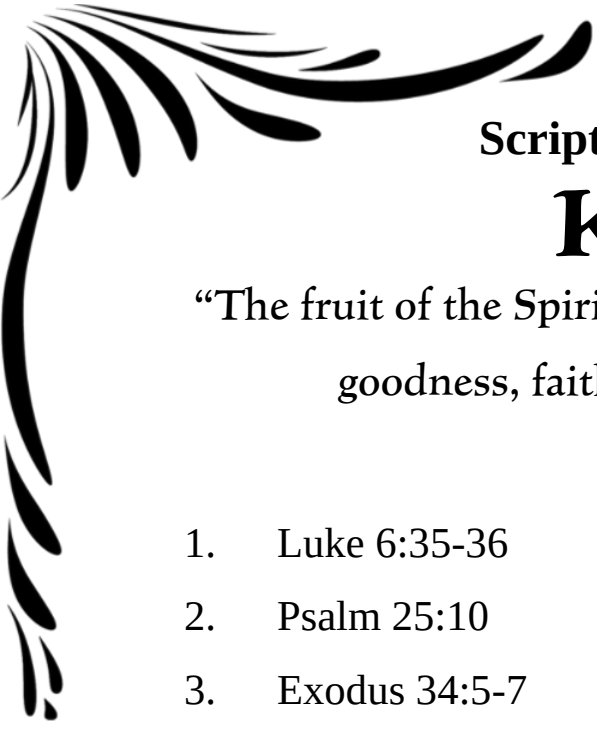
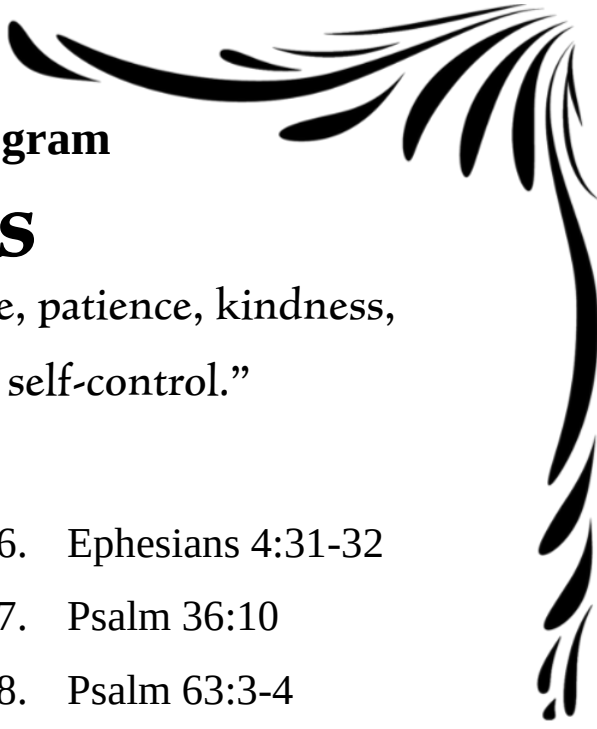

Note: The Greek word used for “kindness” in the fruits of the spirit is *chrestotes*, translated “easy,” “kind,” “good,” or “gracious” All the New Testament verses on this list use that word or a variation. All the Old Testament verses use the Hebrew word *chesed*, which is typically translated “mercy” or “loving kindness.”
